Following recent burglaries in area a male has been arrested who has been wanted for some time for 6 burglaries. 5 of those were on the Havering Borough and 2 of those were in Harold Wood. This is an ongoing investigation but a brilliant result.



We have several days of action booked in the diary where we will be teaming up with our neighbouring wards and patrolling Harold Wood and Harold Hill. There will be a mini bus and plain clothes units out and about to target crime, and show a visibility to the public/residents.
