Budget Council Tax Setting

Unfortunately it's that time of year where all councils up and down the country have to set their council tax for the forthcoming year. This year due to Government's ongoing austerity cuts to budget's Havering has to make a significant amount of savings, which require hard and unpopular decisions to be made on services but ultimately a balanced budget has to be delivered by law. This year the proposed Council Tax increase is 4.26% for a Band D property. Of this increase in Council Tax, the Havering element is 1.25% increase in general expenditure with another 2% ring-fenced for adult social care. Within this 4.26% increase is the Mayor of London precept charge of around 8%.

Whilst the increase may not be welcome, the council are however looking to spend in various areas such as:

- more than 10 million a year to improve roads and pavements as part of a £30 million package over four years
- an extra £400,000 for street cleaning and frequency increased from once every three weeks to fortnightly
- £18.8 million for more school places
- £1.9 million to improve leisure facilities.
- £250,000 to improve community safety through better CCTV
- nearly £150 million as the next instalment of the councils ambitious regeneration plans to see more genuinely affordable housing built and in addition our weekly refuse collection will be retained

As Councillors we vote on the overall budget setting and whilst this year there has been reductions in Council tax support, there is help available by using the Council Tax discretionary relief fund to assist in cases of hardship.

Redden Court MUGA Planning Application

Last month, we reported that the planning application was withdrawn for the Multi Use Games Area ("MUGA") for Redden Court School which is situated in the Emerson Park Ward. This was as a result of nearby

residents concerned about the impact of the installation of floodlighting and the feared nuisance during the hours of darkness. The housing surrounding the site is closer and more dense than at other locations where there is a MUGA. A meeting was held with the ward councillors for that school where residents attended and the application was withdrawn however, this may be resubmitted again with revisions to the plans. Once we hear anything we will pass on.

Mead School, Amersham Road Pedestrian Improvements

The Council are currently consulting on making changes to traffic flow around by Mead School and are consulting on whether to:



make Amersham Road a one-way street, starting at the junction with Harlesden Road/Amersham Walk northbound to Petersfield Avenue;



building out the footway at various points along Amersham Road: south of junction with Petersfield Avenue



Reinstating grass verges at the Amersham Road junction with Amersham Drive.



Extending the footway across
Amersham Road at its junction with
Petersfield Avenue. This will gives
pedestrians right of way when crossing
Amersham Road.

Whilst this consultation is taking place the council will be reconstructing footway in Amersham Road from Petersfield Avenue to Amersham Drive.

Stop the Scavengers from our household waste

We received several complaints from residents regarding the problem with local animals, pests and birds that destroy the black bags that are left outside for the waste collection in search of food etc.

Waste collection times can vary and the dedicated team at Serco collect the rubbish sometimes very early in the morning and most residents put the rubbish bags outside before 7am. But a useful tip to possibly deter wildlife, animals and birds from destroying these sacks is to: Double wrap any food waste and also if residents are concerned about smells attracting, then try placing a bleached soaked piece of kitchen towel within the sack. However, please avoid putting substances like bleach or pepper on the outside or on top of the black bags as this could cause injury to the collection team.

HMOs: Further warnings to criminal landlords

Over 200 formal warning letters have been sent out to those landlords found to be operating inadequate and dangerous living conditions in housing of multiple occupancy (HMOs) in the last month (January).

Havering Council's Landlord Licensing scheme which requires private landlords of HMOs to apply for a licence, is continuing its enforcement action to tackle poor management of private rented homes, overcrowding and anti-social behaviour.

From January 2018 to January 2019, action has included:

- 173,346 licensing fees collected
- 175 final licences issued
- 312,000 penalty notice value.


How to Stay Protected from Scam Calls

A resident has alerted us to a BT Phishing Email scam and if you receive the below email then please be wary. Some guidance is given as to what to look out for but you may find various phone numbers calling you asking to

press various buttons on your telephone keypad.

Please do not press those buttons!

For an easy way to stay safe, BT has put together a list of common tricks that scammers use, so you know what to look out for.



It's probably a scam if someone calls you out of the blue to:

- tell you that your service has been hacked
- try to remotely take control of your computer or another device
- tell you they've found a problem with your computer
- ask you for an urgent payment and threaten to disconnect your service
- ask for payment details to activate Call Protect, Caller Display, or any of BT's free services.

If something doesn't seem right, you can still stay in control. Make sure not to give out any personal details, hang up the phone, and report it on: bt.com/scams

If you want to report a scam or learn more about the free products BT has made to help avoid them, you'll find information on *bt.com/scams*

These are numbers that have telephoned in Jan and Feb 19 with messages that BT line and/or IT connection has been compromised or hacked and they would be discontinued within 24 hours.
