Unfortunately they have not responded to why there has been mismanagement of the project though they have confirmed that there is a new Management Team in place and that contractors are in place to

refit the Ticket Hall and they have again confirmed that this should be finished by December 2019. The Mayor has also indicated that if they are able to bring the lifts into operation sooner then they will. The ongoing public realm work in the car park is scheduled to finish by end March.

Travellers Moved On

Further to our previous updates. We are pleased to announce that the Council have advised us that on Wednesday 11th September the High Court granted

a Havering-wide interim injunction against Travellers. This interim injunction significantly increases the Borough's ability to deal with Traveller incursions, avoiding the need for separate Court

Orders to deal with each incident.

We will keep you updated on any progress and of the final outcome, which should be concluded in about three months time.

BABES IN HAROLD WOOD

It comes as a pleasant surprise when somebody stops me and comments on something I've written in The Bulletin. Usually it's for further information, which is fine if it's within the 66 years I've been a resident. As I came from out of the county, I have only anecdotal data. A generation ago, most residents were from families born and bred here but in-comers like me have taken over. Consequently, we have little firsthand knowledge of past life here and rely on printed records. It would be interesting if any surviving old readers could shed some light on how it was pre-war.

For instance, I was asked if I knew anything about Oak Dene, the apartment block in Gubbins Lane. I recall the site had been a Childrens' home, maybe known as WOODSTOCK and I have heard it was once a smallholding, selling fruit and veg. In the records it's 51, Gubbins Lane but no mention of its history. Does anybody have any information about its past?
