We saved Gooshays Green

We were delighted that the leader of the Council Cllr Damian White announced at the September Council Meeting that the proposal to sell off the council land



and build affordable housing has been withdrawn following ongoing discussions that we have been having. Other councillors may try and claim the credit but here is what we did for the residents of Gooshays and for our residents in Harold Wood that were affected.

Fact 1 - we sent a letter opposing the planning application in March 2019

Fact 2 - we followed this up by email and in writing by opposing the sale of the land in July 2019

Fact 3 - we met with campaigners of Gooshays Green and said we will support them the best we could

Fact 4 - we published in our September 2019 Bulletin that we would support the residents of Gooshays Green and do all we can to help them

Fact 5 - our amendment to a motion on development of this land was focussed purely on Gooshays Green and not on the back of other sites within the borough that the council are looking to develop - we were the only councillors to do this.

Fact 6 - we have had ongoing discussions with the Leader on Gooshays Green whilst other councillors have failed to do so.

VITAL STATISTICS

In the 2011 census the population of Harold Wood was 12,650 and is made up of approximately 51% females and 49% males with the average age being 41.

90% of people living in here were born in England. The remainder's country of birth being: 0.9% India, 0.8% Ireland, 0.6% Nigeria, 0.6% Scotland, 0.5% Wales, 0.3% Zimbabwe, 0.3% Philippines, 0.3% South Africa, 0.3% Pakistan. 42 people identified as a Jedi Knight

Harold Wood is a Havering ward and includes areas of Harold Wood, Gallows Corner, Chadwick and Harold Hill. No, I don't know where Chadwick is.

At Long Last

I am pleased to announce that the white traffic arrows at the junction of Gubbins Lane and Gooshays Drive on the A12 have now been repainted. It took TFL 3 months to complete this work.

Post is now locked

I received a complaint from a resident on the King's Park Estate informing me that the barrier post's padlock had been removed so I contacted the Council Highway Department as this was a safety issue and am pleased to say that this matter has been dealt with swiftly.

Action against the unlicensed landlords

Enforcement by Havering Council has now seen £482,000 issued in penalty notices to criminal landlords in the past 18 months.



During this time, the Council's private housing enforcement team has dealt with the following:

- 157 penalty notices
- 2,837 formal warning letters sent out
- 36 multi-agency enforcement operations [working with the Council's planning enforcement team, police and immigration]

The Council's Landlord Licencing Scheme, which started last year, requires private landlords of HMOs to apply for a licence. The scheme was introduced to tackle the poor management of private rented homes, overcrowding and anti-social behaviour.

The Council will look to see that landlords are licensed correctly and if not, can serve a financial penalty notice for up to £30,000 and those not licensed, could face prosecution.

Feedback is being reviewed from the consultation which took place from June to September this year, to look at proposals to extend the scheme.


