We are receiving a number of complaints from residents so we are ask everyone to consider the above and refrain from damaging the grass verges.

Advice from our Local **Police Team**

We have had an increase in motor vehicle crime recently. We urge you to do what you can to secure your vehicle. Faraday bags are excellent for keyless cars, and steering wheel locks are great for any vehicle for that extra bit of crime prevention. Although Faraday bags are great, also remember that they are not a one-off purchase. With the friction of the keys going in and out of the case the lining does wear down and the signal can then leak. So keep an eye on the lining and replace the case if the lining appears damaged.

A Nation Of Shopkeepers

The sight of the boardedup facade of the travel agent and sweet shop at the junction of Station Rd and Gubbins Lane, got me thinking about the loss of amenities in Harold Wood. Since the early 50's, when I came here,



we have lost a shoe shop, a shoe repairer, barber, milliner, a glazier and wallpaper shop, a timber merchant, seed merchant, couple of iron mongers and 3 banks. On the Oak Rd side, we had two butchers and paper shops. In all, there were getting on for 40 shops, now I make it no more than half that number.

The proliferation of the car, leading to out of town supermarkets, gives more choice, but to young mums and the elderly, the local shops are essential and give a sense of community. It would be nice to have a rebirth of local shops, the station booking hall reopened and breath the clean air of a traffic free Station Road. At least we still have a funeral parlour, which I don't wish to take advantage of just yet!
