BUDGET NEWSFLASH

Great News, following months of negotiation and discussion that we have had, as your local Councillors with the Council Administration, we are absolutely delighted to report that the following matters were confirmed and agreed by the administration at the Budget meeting in February.

- Harold Wood Library will remain open and further discussions will be taking place in due course, to consider extending its current opening hours.
- 30 mins free parking remains in Harold Wood and Harold Hill and returns to on-street parking bays throughout the borough, including Hornchurch, Romford, and Upminster.
- No parking charges will be applicable on a Sunday, across the borough.
- 20% Discount on Parking charges for local residents who will use the new Havering Car Parking Phone App, which is due to be launched in May

Council Motions Update

As reported in our February Bulletin, the 2 motions that we proposed at the January council meeting were both passed and approved by Councillors. Details as follows:

Motion 1 - The first motion was about Fireworks and the impact this has on Animals especially around Guy Fawkes Night and New Year Celebrations. The motion requires the Council:

- To encourage all public firework displays within Havering to be advertised in advance of the event. allowing residents to take precautions for their animals and vulnerable people
- To actively promote a public awareness campaign about the impact of fireworks on animal welfare and vulnerable people - including what can be done to mitigate the risks
- To encourage local suppliers of fireworks to stock 'quieter' fireworks for public display

Motion 2 - This motion was to call upon the Mayor of London to commit more Police Resources to Havering with a particular emphasis on Harold Wood.

The Council will now review these motions and in due course start to implement them.

Refuge and Green Bin collections

Local residents notified us to complain about their scheduled collections being missed or delayed. We immediately chased up both the Council's Streetcare and Environment Services, to get these matters addressed urgently. Thankfully all missed collections were dealt with within 24 hours following our involvement, but have caused disruption for many residents.

The main cause for the delays were due to the collection services vehicles, not being able to gain complete access to certain roads, due to vehicles being parked on both sides of our narrow roads. A number of measures are currently being considered for implementation that will hopefully help to resolve these issues.

Harold Wood Station

A few updates for residents:

- the lifts are now operational within the station and can be used.
- the Car Park Public Realm is progressing reasonably well, though there will be some further delays as work had stalled. TFL need to remove

the temporary ticket offices in the car park before any further work can be completed.

- in respect of safety outside of the station with commuters crossing the road outside the entrance and potentially being a danger to other road users, we have asked the council if railings can be installed. These were taken out a few years ago to reduce street clutter and was done in conjunction with TFL.

However, further to our persistence on this matter the vehicle was removed within two weeks of our initial involvement.

New Railings

Regeneration plans for Cockabourne Court, meant that new railings were to be erected on the boundary line of the property. However, when work started in early January, I was informed of a potential issue that would endanger motorists, as the position of the new railings were actually obscuring the vision from oncoming traffic for motorists who were exiting Archibald road and turning right into Squirrels Heath Road.


I immediately contacted the Council's Projects surveyor and arranged a site visit in order to discuss this problem. All works have now been halted until further notice, in order for the Council to revisit their original design and consider the possibility of taking the line for the Railings further back from the properties boundary line, so that visibility to oncoming motorists could be more safer.

I am hoping to receive an update as soon has a decision has been made.
