#### **OUT OF TOWN**



### **Council Meeting**

For the March Council meeting we have submitted the following questions to the administration in relation to the following

- whether the council would consider bringing back the dog poo campaign which had previously proved so successful in our parks;
- whether the council has any emergency funding to repair the many potholes in our roads that have been caused by heavy rainfall.

We are waiting for the answers on both of these questions.

Also there was a Council EGM in early March around boundary changes to the electoral wards in Havering. We have supported the option which was to widen the Harold Wood ward to take in those areas within Harold Wood that fell into the Emerson Park Ward such as Redden Court, Owlets Hall Close, Prospect, Ravensbourne, Coombe, Beltinge roads and the rest of Squirrels Heath Road. The final decisions on boundary changes will be for the boundary commission to decide upon after public consultation. Final outcome should be known around December this year.
