## Harold Wood Station Update

At the council meeting in September, we raised a question with the Cabinet Member in respect of the progress and completion of Harold Wood Station Public Realm works in the Car Park. We were advised that as a result of TfL's financial situation following the Covid-19 Pandemic, Transport for London (TfL) instructed the Council to

pause all works at Harold Wood station and withdraw from the site, in support of the government lockdown measures. As a consequence, the previously committed funding for the scheme of £250k for 2020/21 was withdrawn. TfL are currently in negotiations with the Department for Transport for the provision of financial support for the second half of the 2020/21 financial Year. The Council will then be informed if there is sufficient funding available to complete the scheme. it is anticipated that a programme of no longer than eight weeks would be required to complete the scheme.
