#### **Tesco Planning Application Protest**



#### What Great News For Us All - Tesco Planning Application REFUSED

Through the hard work of the local Councillors Eagling, Goode and Wise and Ian Jacobs, Sharon Heron and all the campaign team who campaigned so hard against the planning application to build 87 dwellings in Tesco's Car Park, we finally got the result we wanted as the planning application has been refused by Havering Council's Planning Department.

This has been a remarkable achievement following residents protesting at Tesco's in September and previous distribution of approximately 1800 letters by the Harold Wood Hill Park Residents' Association and there was also 1000 leaflets distributed by the Campaign Team.

The Harold Wood Councillors did of course call the planning application in to the Planning Committee though that will not now be needed as this has been refused. We will of course keep an eye on future developments as the Developer could submit another planning application or appeal to the Planning Inspectorate.

#### AS TIME GOES BY

The watches on the back page of glossy magazines intrigue me, as they aren't priced.

As soon as it says Chronometer it's out of my price range. Omega chronographs are upwards of £3000, with the guarantee you can use them at 4 fathoms deep. Actually, I've never needed to know the time underwater.

At the age of 11, I got my first watch, an Ingersoll at 5 bob with a shilling expanding strap. Amazingly it lasted till I got to Egypt in the army when I dropped it from the top bunk in the billet. It seems it was well worn out by then. We left for Palestine and in the middle of Sinai, the troop train stopped and out from the empty desert came assorted Arabs, proffering old English newspapers, dirty books, egg sandwiches, piping hot coffee and watches. At 20, I naively haggled with one, mercilessly knocking him down from £6 to £4, stalemate. As the train lurched into motion we settled on £5, I held out the fiver and grabbed at the watch, he fell back off the carriage into the sand, the watch with the strap secured round his hand and my £5 in the other hand.

When I'd settled in Haifa, Palestine, I saved enough to venture again into the ticking world and for a few quid, acquired a no nonsense working pre-war watch that lasted me till I was presented with an Omega on my 20-yr anniversary at work in 1968. The nameless old watch then gave up and died. I ignored the advice that the Omega should have an annual £3 service, consequently it gradually ingested washing up water and rusted up in a decade. About this time I was given a gift from India, a solid lump of bling by Michael Kors. If I could manage to lift my arm and shield my eyes it did the job. Then the battery died. I was confident my friendly watch repairer Mr Tyler in North St Romford would fix it, but he pointed out he didn't have the special tools needed to open it. He didn't have much trouble selling me a £6 Casio, which outlasted him. After

5 years it too died, so I bought another basic Casio on line for £5, no problem with servicing or battery changing and at 95 I shan't bother to insure it to tell me the time at 4 fathoms deep for eventually when I'm 4 fathoms deep, time will be endless!






