### Harold Wood Park/Pages **Wood Bridge**

Our motion to Council was also passed and we have now called upon the Council to effect a meeting with the forestry commission and relevant stakeholders, including the ward councillors, to discuss possible solutions for bringing back direct access from the park into Pages Wood. However, It was very disappointing to note that Councillors who are part of the HRA, did not support our motion for the bridge especially when this area is regularly used by residents in Upminster, Cranham and Hornchurch who they represent.
