The council visited the site very quickly, but having identified dangerous materials within the rubbish, the council had to appoint a specialist firm to arrange its removal. Thankfully the rubbish has now been cleared and Enforcement officers are now investigating this matter in order to try and establish who was responsible for this Fly tip.



This behaviour is an absolute disgrace and the offenders should be prosecuted if sufficient evidence can be obtained.

Fly -Tipping is a serious criminal offence and offenders could receive a very hefty penalty fine or a prison sentence.

Harold Wood Park -Bridge Update

Following our Council motion and petition towards the end of last year, a meeting was arranged between ward councillors, forestry commission, council officers, a representative for the MP and the Chair of the Friends of the Harold Wood Parks.

To summarise the below are key actions that need to take place.

- Old rainbow bridge has been condemned and needs to be removed and the Environment agency has to provide permission to do this. The Forestry commission Budget appears to have been sanctioned for this removal.
- Rainbow Bridge to be replaced

cost is around 60k to 70k and Forestry commission are gaining designs, costings etc. The Environment agency will need to confirm details of design etc and confirmation that a second bridge can be constructed.

- Temporary access via the concrete bridge to be made safer and the work has commenced. We as your councillors will be attending the site with council officers to discuss further improvements and potential issues.

It was conveyed at the meeting that the temporary access will not be able to be used by a very large proportion of our community including disabled, blind, elderly and those with a young family.

All those attending the meeting were in favour of the reinstatement of the Rainbow bridge, however much will be determined by the decisions of the Environmental Agency.


