
# St. Peter's Flower and Craft Festival 2022

### **New Council Administration**

As you may know that there has been a change of administration at the Council following the local elections. We will wait to see what policies and improvements are being made before we pass judgement but we will be monitoring and scrutinising to ensure that Harold Wood is not

left out and disadvantaged as a result of these changes.


It is surprising and hypocritical that the HRA were very critical of HW Councillors working closely over the last 4 years with the last administration to try and get the best outcomes for Harold Wood yet they have aone into coalition with Labour and have given 2 key Chair positions to Conservative Councillors. This is after them saying that they would not enter into a coalition with Labour. On top of this, the 15% Special Responsibilities Allowance cut that we proposed and got passed at the Budget in March has now been superceded and the Leader has in effect given himself a pay rise of a £1000. We note that a new committee structure has been introduced but this will somewhat reduce scrutiny of the administration however we do acknowledge that as a result of this that some further savings in allowances will be made.

As your elected councillors, we will always fight for the residents of our area and we hope that you can support us in the coming years as we see what benefits this new administration arrangement will bring to the borough.

## Baby, it's cold outside

My Great-grand children enjoy a daily swim in a heated pool. Whilst sharing their excitement, I don't envy them. I was brought up in a Victorian terrace house with just one cold water tap in the scullery. Mum believed the excess use of cold water was better than namby-pamby hot water and my raw neck proved it. My only contact with immersing in warm water was in the River Lea where the electricity supply people diverted a stream to take the heat out of the cooling towers by running cold water over the pipes and returning it to the Lea. The now warm water was great and I swallowed gallons of it, though what it did to the cold water wild life I can't imagine.

The opening of Enfield cold water Lido in the 30's should have helped, but when the weather was hot, the queues snaked across the car park (few people had cars)



patiently awaited the bell that signalled two hours was up and the pool emptied and they were nearer getting in. In normal weather, they allowed people in once the water temperature reached 16 degrees. These weren't normal people I'm certain.

My break with outdoor swimming in Britain came on a February Sunday in '44.

We of the Enfield Home Guard paraded as usual and marched to the Lido. The gates were unlocked and we were ordered to stand to attention at the waters edge. It appears what was considered as commando training was to jump in, rifles on ones back and splash out for the far bank, the non-swimmers holding their rifles in front of them and kicking out with as much dignity as one could muster! The shock of this ridiculous action was such that I've no memory of the rest of the parade. At 17, it didn't help with my development and I've avoided cold water swimming ever since!
