If you enjoy gardening and have a garden to be proud of then why not enter the 2022 Havering in Bloom competition which has opened and will close on 2 September 2022.



Forestry England's application for the replacement bridge was duly made on the 15th



We are pleased that the removal of the existing bridge was started on time and has now been completely removed. A temporary barrier has now been installed at the end of the path until the new bridge is installed.

Harold Wood Station Tannoy Announcements

Over the last few months we have received complaints from residents about the Tannoy system at Harold Wood Station being too loud and the frequency of these.

I have been in contact with our GLA member to take the matter up with TFL and TFL undertook site visits in May to test the sound, which uncovered a volume issue and the volume was subsequently lowered. The number of announcements playing at Harold Wood was also reduced. TFL have amended the timings of the security public announcement so it starts later and finishes earlier.

Hopefully this has helped local residents living in the vicinity of the station.

ULEZ Extension of the Zone

TFL are consulting on proposals to expand the Ultra Low Emission Zone Londonwide on 29 August 2023. They want to hear your views on the proposals. These proposals are part of the commitment by

the Mayor of London and TfL to help improve air quality and public health, tackle the climate emergency and reduce traffic congestion across Greater London.

This will affect and impact Havering residents and it is important that you

Whilst traffic congestion and air quality in central London is more noticeable, outer London Boroughs such as Havering are not as impacted by this so is this just another money making scheme by the London

Shepherd's Hill/Phillida

Following feedback from residents, we have formally handed in a petition to the council to consult on implementing parking restrictions in Shepherds Hill (either side of the Array) and Phillida Road. This will take some time to consult and implement if indeed the Council approves the restrictions in the first place.

Regular Flooding in **Harold View**

After consistently chasing the Council up and reporting the regular Flooding problem, I was pleased to receive a report confirming that an Inspection was carried out and a number of surface water manholes in the area were found to be blocked.

Following this inspection, Thames water have been instructed to jet & clear out a number of the neighbouring sewers and drains that are causing this repeated Flooding issue, especially after the heavy downpour of rain.

School Streets Consultation Harold Wood Primary School/Redden Court

As you may know the council will be launching its School Streets initiative locally (for Harold Wood Primary School and Redden Court School) and across other schools in Havering from September. This was following the sending out of 654 consultation letters to residents locally. The scheme is part of the Mayor of London TfL's Sustainable Travel: Active, Responsible, Safe (STARS) scheme; which has been developed for London schools and nurseries and is intended to inspire young people to travel to school sustainably, actively, responsibly and safely by championing walking, scooting and cycling

Furthermore the council has issued letters to residents detailing the exemptions to the scheme which can be applied for by residents living in the following roads from 25th July 2022 - Cotswold Road, Upland Court Road, Recreation Ave, Beltinge Road, Coombe Road and Ravensbourne Crescent. The scheme will run in term

time only Monday to Friday 8.15am to 9am and 2.30pm to 3.30pm. The trial will run for 18 months and the first 6 months will be used as a consultation period for any feedback. A copy of the letter can be found on our website.

SIMPLE INTEREST


