NEWSFLASH!

Council tax is set to increase under the HRA/Labour Administration to 5.94%.

Parking charges Free 30 mins to remain but 1hr parking charge to increase to £2.10 and up to £5.10 for up to 3hrs.

Resident's Parking permits per annum. Charges, will now double in cost on all permits from April.

Example:1st permit per household was £35 will increase to £70; 2nd permit per household was £60 will increase to £140.

Be Aware - Think outside the box



Havering Council is reminding drivers not to get caught out in a yellow box junction. To help traffic flow more easily with less congestion, camera enforcement is increasing on traffic contraventions like banned turning movements, drivers ignoring one-way signs, driving in a bus lane and those who wait in a yellow box junction.

You may enter a yellow box junction when your exit is clear and there is enough space on the other side of the junction for your vehicle to clear the box completely without stopping. You can stop in a yellow box junction when turning right if you are prevented from turning by oncoming traffic, or by other vehicles waiting to turn right.

The locations that we are aware of are:
Main Road/Upper Brentwood Road
Havering Road/Collier Row Lane
Hornchurch Road/Abbs Cross Lane

After making contact with the Forestry Commission back in September 2021 regarding the condition of the Rainbow bridge in Harold Wood Park it was found to be unsafe and had to be closed off and we were informed it would cost around £60,000 to replace.

The bridge was not the responsibility of the Council so we had to deal with the Forestry Commission and we spent many months of meetings, complaining and pushing for the replacement of the bridge but we felt we were getting nowhere. We then brought up a motion at Full Council Meeting and handed in a 725 signature petition to get the Council involved and we were successful in this and things started to move forward.

It has been a slow process but we are pleased to say that the new bridge has arrived and works have begun to fit and secure the bridge into place, in order for the residents of Harold Wood and neighbouring area to use and again explore Pages Wood.
