Budget Update!

The HRA/Labour budget for 2023/2024 has now been set and finalized.

Below is a summary of what increases will be implemented from April:

- Council Tax: to increase by 5.94%.
- The majority of Council fees and charges will be increased by 4%
- Council Tenants: Rent to increase by approx. 7%
- Tenants will also have to self-fund any replacement items below £50
- Pay and Display Parking charges: Free 30 minutes to remain but Charges have increased: 1 hour charge will increase to £2.10 and for up to 3 hours £5.10
- Resident's Parking Permits per annum, charges will now double in cost on all permits. Each individual vehicle will now cost £70

The HRA/Labour administration promised change, it has now arrived.

Beware Parking Fines

Under the new administration of HRA and Labour the parking wardens have been instructed to be more productive in issuing parking tickets. Our advice is, if you are unable to obtain a ticket, unable to use Ringo and cannot get through to the Council's Parking Department from the number on the machine DO NOT PARK there without authorisation or you will receive a parking fine. Please ensure you park within the white marked parking bays because even one inch over a parking ticket will be issued.

The Administration boasted of change within the borough - Did they mean issuing more parking fines.

TFL Bus Consultation

TFL have launched a consultation proposing changes to bus routes 346, 347 and 497 in Harold Wood and Upminster.

TFL have reviewed bus services in east Havering to ensure services are meeting customer needs and have taken account of feedback from a previous consultation about the 497 held in autumn 2021. A key message from that consultation was a request for bus links between Harold Wood and Upminster.



Protest against ULEZ

At the Budget setting Council Tax meeting last month, there were hundreds of protestors complaining about the proposed ULEZ Scheme coming to Havering and all London Boroughs in August 2023. There was a proposal at the meeting for Havering to fund legal action along with some other London Boroughs to challenge the scheme by launching an action for judicial review though unfortunately the Havering Residents Association and Labour coalition administration voted against this proposal. The administration have said they are against the scheme in principle but they are not backing up their words by joining the legal action. Actions speak louder than words but in this case it seems the other way round!

School Streets

The council may be introducing 10 or more School Street schemes later this year. The council said that the existing School Streets Schemes have been reviewed and worked well though they have acknowledged that some displacement has occurred on other roads nearby. The council have said they are listening to feedback and TFL has allocated funding to assess the impact. The council will look to put further parking restrictions in place as the School Streets programme develops and they will consult later this year with residents on the phase 2 schools that were implemented in September last year.

Questions Raised at Council

At the March meeting of the council, we asked 2 questions in relation to the following: 1) Whether there are any plans to introduce Low Traffic Neighbourhood Schemes within the borough as we are concerned that some of Havering's Roads could be closed off to accommodate any schemes of this nature; and 2) We have also asked how many Penalty Charge

Notices have been issued over the 2nd half of 2022 as we have seen an increase in the number of complaints and we believe this is on the back of the Council increasing the number of Parking Enforcement Officers that are employed by the Council. As at the time of writing we are waiting for official responses to be sent back. As we highlighted last month, it seems 'War on the Motorist' yet again.

Pot Holes Defects and Repairs



We continue to raise concerns over the number of Pot holes and defects that are appearing on our roads and pavements and especially the inadequate repairs that are carried out when actioned by the Council. In particular 2 pot holes that recently appeared in Church Road. Three times these have had to be repaired in a very short period of time. Our list of action required for the repair of these Pot holes are growing, but we continue to chase the Council for these to be repaired.
