Council's Administration Announce a massive 'U' turn on their increased permit fees for Residential **Parking Bays**

As reported in our March Bulletin, the Labour/HRA Administration voted in at the Budget Council tax meeting to double the cost for residents parking

permit fees. At the time the Harold Wood Councillors expressed their dismay and disagreement with this increase. In his budget Speech Cllr Goode, stated on our behalf and that of the HW residents auite clearly

that these increases were unacceptable. undeliverable and unachievable. Not one member of the Cabinet or Administration members challenged him or said anything different in relation to the parking permit fees being doubled in

Since the budget meeting, there have been numerous emails back and forth between opposition members and the administration with regards to the doubling of the fees as residents had been complaining that they have now been charged double for their Parking permit renewal. The administration are now back-tracking on what they voted for in the budget and are saying that the increases have been applied in error and that they knew nothing about the 100% plus increases for parking permits and

that they should have been at a much lower level of increase even though they voted for the doubling of the cost. However rather than admitting that they made a mistake, they have the audacity to blame the error on council officers which is unacceptable. We knew about the proposed changes in February, as we published this in our March Bulletin so the figures were known by the time of the Budget Meeting on March 1st. The Council have now confirmed to us that the increase in parking permit fees will only increase by £5 for the first permit which is a much lower increase and we have been advised that refunds will be issued in due course to any residents that have renewed. Whilst we welcome the 'U' turn by the administration, this does leave the council in a precarious financial position as it has been stated by the Leader that this is no longer a balanced budget. All Councils are legally required to agree a balanced budget each year otherwise this has to be reported to the Government. We have taken this matter up with the Chief Executive to establish the full facts here as we are uncomfortable with what we have heard on this matter and would like to know the current legal position of the council.


