Wildflowers Destroyed



It is with great frustration that contractors have cleared the wildflower area within the Station Carpark. This is private land managed by TfL and we have asked the council and TFL if it was their contractors that cleared the area though unfortunately both authorities have denied this. Last autumn pupils from Harold Wood and Harold Court primary schools, along with volunteers and other community groups worked hard on this over the last year to plant over £200 of wildflowers seeds which had been kindly donated by members of the community. The wild poppies, cornflowers and other plants that had started to bloom, have all been cut down by these contractors. Rachel Grimwood who organised the initial planting of the flowers has been liaising with TFL and they have agreed for the area to be replenished in the Autumn as a generous community gesture. School Absences

The Council has launched a new drive to reduce the number of children missing school.

The move is to stop pupils falling behind on their studies and to help parents and pupils to realise the impact that missing school can have on children long-term.

New laws introduced last year, give local authorities permission to not only work with Council-run schools, but also academies to look at the trends for missing school and how to tackle them.

Although at present, school attendance for Havering children is a little higher than the national average - with 94% for Primary and 92% for Secondary, the Council is working to improve these figures.

Some parents may feel 90% of their child's

attendance is acceptable however, this equates to half a day a week of missed school, which adds up to four weeks throughout a school year.

There is a range of help and support available and parents should discuss any concerns with their child's school for advice and auidance.

It certainly seems that this area is being targeted and is on the increase so we would urge you to keep any valuables hidden and preferably not inside your vehicle, ensure your doors are locked, windows shut and your keys are in a faraday pouch. Also why not consider a steering lock as well. Try and make it difficult for these car thieves as ultimately it will push up all our insurance premiums. School Streets survey

Residents living within the Redden Court/ Harold Wood Primary school streets zone have been sent a letter along with the school's themselves to ask them to undertake a survey on the scheme and how it is operating. The council will then make a decision after to decide whether to make this scheme permanent or have it removed and this decision must be within 18 months of the start of the experimental scheme.

We immediately contacted the council to arrange for its removal and the Council have confirmed, that the tree will be removed as soon as they can. Cllr Eagling, went to visit the site and as you can see from the photograph this was quite a large tree.



Phillida Road and Shepherds Hill

The council have now publicly advertised to implement double yellow lines on one side of Phillida Road as residents requested this following parking issues from Array customers. These should be installed soon once the legal formalities have been completed. With regards to Shepherds Hill, there has been site visits by officers to work up a scheme and a plan and we will be updated on this in due course. We will keep you informed of any updates.

Beware of the Scammers

Fraudsters are becoming even more sophisticated in their ways they manipulate and con people out of their hard earned savings. Recently, there have been a number of notices that have been sent to individuals by email that appear to be from their own bank, sometimes even including previous messages, so they do look genuine, but they are false. Money can be transferred immediately from your account if you follow the instructions that are given in these false email messages.

If you do receive an email that appears to be from your bank or building society or looks suspicious, please be extra cautious: Do not click on any link that is provided or telephone the number that is provided in the email.

The best way to check to see if the notice that you have received is genuine or not, is to call your Bank or Building Society directly by using the telephone number that your Bank has provided to you which normally appears, either on your bank card or statement. Your bank or building society will be only too happy to help and to confirm if it was them or not, who sent you the message. They will also provide you with advice on what you should do.


Don't Get a Parking Fine
