We will be keeping an eye on this to ensure that they keep to their commitment.


ULEZ/Pay Per Mile Extraordinary Council Meeting

Following our request to call an Extraordinary meeting with other opposition members to discuss this topic and force the administration to act it was agreed by all councillors for the Council to call upon the Mayor of London to stop the expansion of ULEZ into outer London Boroughs and that we oppose any roll-out of Pay per Mile by TFL. We have also committed the council to support its vulnerable residents in applying for ULEZ exemptions and scrappage.

Whilst we are not expecting the Mayor of London to change his mind it will

certainly focus people's minds on whether to vote for the current Mayor next May when GLA and London Mayor elections take place. This ULEZ extension scheme should have been phased in over a number of years and indeed larger amounts of scrappage costs should have been given to vehicle owners of non-compliant cars. Car owners may now be paying £12.50 a day but is the air any cleaner for it?

Adults with Disabilities

Following on from a topic group that I chaired on this subject earlier in the year, I have presented a number of recommendations that the group are now asking the Cabinet to implement. The group's initial focus was to consider employment opportunities for adults over 25 with a range of

disabilities including learning disabilities and Autism. The key recommendations are:

- To ask Cabinet to employ a specialised Supported employment Adviser for Adults with Disabilities to work alongside day provision and support transition to internships and paid employment
- Improve employability opportunities
- Develop schemes with local businesses to help provide employment opportunities for adults 25+
- Expanding council operated services for jobs
- Ensure Havering's local offer (16-25) is comprehensive and detailed with signposting to identify current apprenticeships
- To create, maintain and monitor 'Quality Standards' for providers within Havering and benchmark against other local authorities and more importantly establishing a formal framework for providers to set their standards and allowing frequency of monitoring and inspection
- Ensuring there is a specialised, meaningful set of activity programs for 25+ residents with disabilities.



If her smart phone ran out of battery power she'd be in trouble.



Well done to Danielle Jones who organised a Fund Raising day for the London Air Ambulance on Saturday the 8th September 2023 in Harold




