# Dire Straits - Bankruptcy is Looming

We are not talking about the rock group but the dire straits that this Council is facing financially. Many of you will have seen recent stories about the council facing financial difficulties and that the council may face a section 114 notice which in effect means that the council will face bankruptcy. If this notice is issued this will allow the Government to send in inspectors who will take control of the council and manage day to day spending. Other councils such as Croydon and Birmingham have faced similar situations.

Any intervention will see the council stop spending on non-essential items and ultimately, we may see council buildings and assets etc sold off to pay its debts and unfortunately council tax could significantly increase. This intervention may not come for another 6-12 months and in the interim we will probably see large spending cuts being put in place on council budgets. This could mean traffic schemes not being approved, fortnightly bin collections and improvements to roads and pavements being put on hold.

This is disastrous for Havering if it happens and the HRA and Labour Administration will have a lot to answer for to the electorate.

As you know, Harold Wood Councillors are not part of this administration, and it is sad to see how bad the finances have become since the new administration took over in May 2022. Maybe the Leader of the Council should step aside so that a new approach and ideas can be sought!

# **Parking Meters**

Havering Council is currently replacing all of its Pay and Display machines across the borough.

This will be completed by the end of the

New machines will no longer accept coins, however people will have the ability to pay contactless with debit and credit cards, or use nearby PayPoint facilities to continue paying with cash.

Residents will still be eligible for the free 30 minutes parking in on-street parking bays, except in Romford. They can activate this by either calling the number displayed on site or using the RingGo app.

The Council has also reviewed the use of machines in less-used locations and where machines are constantly

### Refuse Wheelie Bins

We sometimes get asked whether we can get wheelie bins rather than a sack collection for when our refuse gets collected. We have been told that there are currently no plans to introduce wheelie bins but it is an option they may have to consider. Havering's new collection contract with Urbaser includes the option to introduce wheelie bins during the contract duration, with the vehicles having the capability to be retrofitted with bin lifts.

If wheelie bins were to be introduced then this is a substantial investment for Havering to make, estimated at around

£2m for one wheelie bin per kerbside property and increased if wheelie bins were to also be introduced for recyclable materials. The containers would need to be maintained when damage or theft occurs which would incur further costs and administration, as well as the purchase and installation of bin lifts for the collection vehicles, and reprofiling collection rounds to account for additional time taken to empty and return bins. Consideration also needs to be given to properties that cannot facilitate a wheeled bin or number of wheeled bins/containers, such as terraced properties and those with smaller front gardens.

### **Finally**

After reporting this overgrown section to the Council a few months ago and having chased them on numerous occasions, it was great to see this area finally cut back much to the delight of the resident whom raised this with Cllr Wise.

In addition, a resident also contacted us to get the bushes cut back in Kersey

Gardens and on this occasion the council was quick off the mark.

As you know we are always reporting issues to the council and sometimes they act fast and at other times they drag their feet but we always try to constantly chase them up.

We declared war on this particular Sunday. My Dad, as a reservist, had reported to the Army on Friday 1st Sept. I assumed he'd gone off to Poland to stop the nastiness

So, on the Sunday, Mum and I decided to have dinner with Gran who lived a couple of miles away, thus saving the expense of buying

a roast. I was full of anticipation of something exciting in the air whereas Mum was strangely quiet. She'd been just this age when World War 1 started and I too was in the week of my 13th birthday this time. She knew that it wasn't going to be a picnic, I was quite excited.

The banshee wail of an air raid siren split the peace of a Sunday. An air raid warden appeared and insisted we got off the street, mainly by a constant blowing of his whistle. We hurried home, with not a Heinkel or Junkers in sight, much to my dismay.

The radio suddenly became the depressing voice of authority. We had no meals in the house. Nobody I knew had a fridge, one shopped


every day and everything was shut as if the world was coming to an end, which it was, in a way.

Equally, nobody we knew had a 'phone, so we couldn't tell anyone we'd survived our first bombing! Mum and I sat, awaiting the bombardment, The Anderson air raid shelter hadn't been erected. Luckily nothing happened and, had we known it, not a lot would initially, but quite a storm was coming up in the coming year, enough to supply this magazine with material for quite a time.
