Car Crime (Church Road) Area

Parking Scheme Requests

We have a number of scheme requests open with the Council for our ward however earlier in the year they changed the process on how they assess them and now they undertake a triage assessment and make an initial decision on the viability of the request. However this is all dependent on the council having appropriate funding to be able to pay for these and we must war with the current financial climate at the Council, some or none of these may proceed at all. Here are the scheme requests currently waiting for assessment and recommendation from Council officers.

- Request free parking bay along the flank wall of 15 New Hall Drive
- Request for footway parking bays Craven Gardens
- Request to change a Free parking bay into a Residents parking Bay -The

Drive

- Request to extend the double yellow lines – Holt Road
- Request for traffic calming measures/ improvements (Nags Head Lane & Hall Lane
- Request to extend the double yellow lines up to properties 79 101 Rosslyn Ave
- Request for Safety Improvements on Warley Road on Brentwood/Havering Border
- Request for Double Yellow lines in Melksham Close (One side of the road)
- Request for resident only parking during a set time (Permit Parking Area) in Hamilton Drive/Douglas Ave – It is likely an informal consultation with residents will have to take place first before advancing any further.

Rip-Off Havering!

The Council has launched its budget consultation and some of the proposals are going to hit us all in the pocket!

We urge Harold Wood residents to please respond to the consultation to give your views on! Some of the key proposals include:

- 50% increase in the cost of hiring football pitches in our parks.
- Car Park charging to be introduced in Parks and charged at the same amount as council car parks and on street parking
- Parking charges to increase by 40% with 1 hr going from £2.10 to £3
- Removal of the 50% discount if PCN appeal is unsuccessful
- Increasing the number of controlled parking zones as well as increasing the cost of residents parking permits
- Reducing the level of street lighting from midnight to 5am by turning down the brightness.
- Increase garden waste and bulky waste collection costs by 20%
- Fortnightly refuse collections for black bag waste and recycling.
- Closure of some smaller libraries
- Cancel Xmas spending on trees and lights in the borough.

Autism Hub

The council has announced that they are

no longer going to support the Autism Hub in Romford and it is likely they will have no alternative other than to close its doors. Since opening in October 2015, the Autism Hub has provided support, guidance and respite for the Havering autistic community. It is the location of a huge number of services, including a Peer Group for young adults on the spectrum, an outreach service for hardto-reach adults in the community and the Autism Steering Group, which feeds into the Council's Autism Strategy. The most recent version of the Havering Autism Strategy refers to the Autism Hub throughout and was launched from the Hub in April this year. In addition, the Hub includes a Sensory Room, where autistic people can seek shelter if overwhelmed by the sensory experience of the shopping centre, and has provided a valuable service for Havering adults to get help with applications for Personal Independence Payments. More importantly, it has provided a valuable safe space for the Havering autistic community, who are welcomed without question by Hub staff and volunteers. We have requested the relevant scrutiny committee to examine the councils decision and whether any alternative solutions were considered. THE WAY WE WERE

I keep thinking I'm beginning to adjust to being bereaved after these few sad confusing months, but 74 years of marriage fixes a pattern in one's routine.

Both of us reaching our nineties meant it wasn't a noisy home, but I can't get used to the almost absolute silence when I come home to the empty house. At 97, I no longer want music or the radio playing, I can't start a book and we never did have TV on in daytime. There is the opposite effect when I'm in a crowded room, everything seems noisier and I'm just as uncomfortable! I'm gradually getting back into connecting with people and even though most coffee morning groups are mixed, there is a predominance of women and, dare I say, therefore somewhat noisier. Going home from such a gathering seems to amplify the silence, as it were. On the other hand, it's been the ladies who have reached out to offer condolences, for which I've been grateful.

There's no formula for coping with bereavement so I can only talk of my experiences.

I didn't want company, however well meaning. After six months, I'm beginning to circulate again, though coming back to an empty house means I've no one to share the events with. Writing this column seems to open a few doors again and next month I'm supposed to go to a quiz, which I'm preparing myself for.

The pleasure of daily sunshine has helped as I can enjoy a daily walk round the park. Quite often I feel like extending my walk but the feeling wears off after a while and I sneak home, even though the house is just as empty as when I left it. Not only

have I never been alone before, I've never been 97 before and that too takes some accepting.

My loving, caring daughter pointed out my good fortune in being fit, with no underlying illnesses, being able to get out and mix with such nice people as my generation. So, I guess I'll carry on carrying on about things and putting it all down on paper.


